

Information for authors

The Editorial Board accepts original not published earlier edited articles on theoretical and applied problems of international relations which are of scientific and practical value.

The articles should be submitted in two copies in Ukrainian, Polish or English.

While preparing articles for publication the authors are asked to follow the following rules:

1. The article should be typed on one side of a standard sheet in a clear type line spaced 1.5. Indentation 0.5. The volume of the article should be 8-12 full pages. Text files should be submitted as Word documents, font Times New Roman (size 14). The files should be named with the surname of the author (first author) in Latin letters. The author(s) take the responsibility for the accuracy of the facts, quotations, statistical data, geographical and proper names. The files should be submitted on the CD-R/RW disks.
2. The quotation marks should be put as follows: «», dash – «—». There should be no unnecessary spaces, especially before brackets and square brackets as well as within them. Manual tabulation and hyphenation should not be used either.
3. The article should be supplied with two reviews, the information about author(s) (the name and surname, academic degree, the workplace, position, office and home addresses, telephone number, e-mail address).
4. The article should begin with a UDC, the title of the article and information about the author(s) (the name and surname, academic degree, the workplace, position, office and home addresses, telephone number, e-mail address) and a summary of the article in Ukrainian with keywords.
5. Digital data, if possible, should be presented in the form of tables and not repeated in the text. The tables should be compact, have captions and be numbered. Under each table the source of information should be indicated. The graphical material should not be extensive and not exceed 30% of the volume of the text of the article. Graphs, diagrams and charts should not be overloaded with labels. The width of the tables, graphs, diagrams and charts should not be larger than 135 mm. Words and word combinations should not be abbreviated, except conventional abbreviations of measures and terms.
6. References should be made in square brackets and numbered according to the numbering of the Bibliography which is presented in the alphabetical order at the end of the article. The number of the page in a reference should be separated by a comma: [14, p.93] where 14 is the number of the source according to the Bibliography, 93 – the number of the page. The Bibliography is followed by its

duplication in Latin letters (transliteration should be performed according to the State Standard).

7. The text of the article should be followed by the title of the article, information about the author(s) (the name and surname, academic degree, the workplace, position, office and home addresses, telephone number, e-mail address) and a summary of the article in English with keywords. The volume of the summary in Ukrainian should be 900–1,000 characters, in English – 1,000–2,000 characters. The summary should be structured, include the aim of investigation and the methods used, main conclusions.
8. The article should be submitted together with the summary in English (not less than 4,000 characters) to be placed on the Web-site of the Journal. The summary of the article should present its contents and be structured, include the aim of investigation and the methods used, main results of the investigation.
9. The Editorial Board will not consider articles that do not conform with the above rules.

The Editorial Board will deposit the electronic variant of the article to V. Vernadskiy National Library of Ukraine. By submitting the article the author(s), at the same time, gives permission for its publication in full on the website of the V. Vernadskiy National Library of Ukraine according to the Order of the Higher Attestation Commission of Ukraine and National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine # 436/311 of 07.07.2008, as well as on the websites of the Ivan Franko National University of Lviv and the Scientific Library of the Ivan Franko National University of Lviv.
