Guidelines for Authors

Authors intending to publish their abstracts at the VII International Scientific Conference "Ecological and Economic Problems of International Trade" are required to submit their abstracts in one of the following languages: Ukrainian, English, Polish, or Bulgarian.

Manuscripts should adhere to the following guidelines:

- 1. The manuscript should typically not exceed 4 pages of printed text, typed in 14 pt Times New Roman with 1.5 line-spacing. Margins should be set at 20mm.
- 2. The abstract should be written in English, Ukrainian, Polish, or Bulgarian.
- 3. The title should include the author(s)' name(s), scientific degree and position, affiliation, full work address, telephone numbers, and email address.
- 4. The abstract should have the following structure:
- Key words (up to 20 symbols each);
- Introduction: formulation of the scientific problem and its connection with important scientific or practical tasks;
- Main body of the article: containing all relevant information with substantiation of obtained scientific results;
- Conclusions and prospects for future research.
- List of references.
- 5. All illustrations and tables should be numbered and accompanied by brief descriptive titles. Page numbering, as well as numbering for tables, diagrams, etc., should be done using Arabic numerals.

Before publication, all manuscripts will undergo peer-review.

All editorial corrections will be made on behalf of the authors.

Abstracts that do not meet the above requirements will not be considered.

The material submitted must not have been previously published or presented at any major meeting. All authors are responsible for ensuring the accuracy of the data submitted.
