

3. FORM OF HIGHER EDUCATION STUDENT ATTESTATION

Attestation stands for the examination of the correspondence of the level and scope of knowledge, abilities, other competences acquired by higher education students to the requirements of higher education standards.

Attestation is performed in the form of public presentation (demonstration) of the qualification master paper;

The master paper should be performed and presented in English in front of a joint board consisting of the faculty delegated by both Universities.

The state attestation board should check the theoretical and practical training of the graduate, settle the issue of assigning the educational level of master to him/her by qualification and providing the respective education document of the state sample approved in accordance with the applicable legislation.

Attestation of persons getting the master degree may take place in the form of a unified state qualification exam in the specialties and following the procedure established by the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine.

On the basis of the results of attestation the following qualification are assigned: Master. “Lawyer-International Law. Master in International Law. Master in Law.
